Referring my telegram November 5th re Union Russian Workers. Instructions contained in my wire November 5th should be carried out in detail by you on Friday evening November 7th at most opportune time. Proceed thereafter at once with examinations. Immigration inspectors have been instructed to communicate with you today for purpose of cooperating. Upon completion of examination subjects should be turned over to immigration inspectors. In conducting examination refer to my confidential letter of instructions of August 12th, 1919, relative to kind of evidence necessary for deportation proceedings. Upon completion of examination wire at once in detail results of your work if possible not later than 10 o'clock Saturday morning November 8th. Five. Stop.
